 4. Your interests outside of 4-H
 5. Your future plans
- Applicants will be notified if a personal interview is deemed necessary.
- Scholarship recipient is responsible for sending proof of completion of the first semester and a schedule of classes for the second semester to the address listed above.
- Payment: Payment will be made directly to the recipient upon proof of completion of the first semester as well as a class schedule for the second semester.
