### **Marilyn Amundson—Master Gardener Volunteer – Ready Set Grow**

Participants will learn steps to preparing for their gardens, including container gardens. Discussion topics will include gardening tips, such as the importance of bees and companion gardening. Activities will include making row markers and assembling seed tapes. We will also start some seeds using egg cartons and newspaper pots. Fair entries for both 4-H and open class will be reviewed.

What we will be doing – Learn about your family and who you came from as you make a family tree on FamilySearch, add family records, document sources and make memories. You will see what info. US Census gives, what vital records contain and how newspapers can help in family history research. Suggestions for interviewing an older relative will also be given. You will be ready for exhibiting your project at the fair after this workshop.
