Enclosed with this letter is the Lamb Project Registration form. You are receiving this prior to the registration and weigh-in date on April 22nd to help speed up the registration and weigh-in process. **Please complete the top one/half only of the registration form, and bring to weigh-ins. Do not sign the form until after your lambs are weighed, tagged, and registered, and you have verified the weight and tag number of your lambs.** Each member will need an individual form.

Lamb Weigh-in schedule

When: April 22nd
Time: 5pm – 8pm
Where: at the Barron County Fairgrounds, Triebensee Barn

Members may register and weigh up to five lambs.

Sale Eligibility is as follows:

- Maximum weight at beginning weigh-in is **90 pounds**
- Minimum final weight at the fair is **110 pounds**
- Lambs must grade prime or choice in the live show
- The average Rate of Gain (ROG) for sale eligibility is .45 pounds per day

Members will be required to pay \$3 per animal for tag expense. This is to be paid at weigh-ins. Please bring the correct amount as no change will be returned. Checks will be accepted and should be made payable to Barron County Livestock Committee.
