Biosecurity Tips for the show season

Keep your horse up-to-date on vaccines.

Wash your hands often!

Keep sick horses at home. Monitor them for fever, diarrhea and nasal discharge.

over 102 F Call your vet!

Separate and monitor:

- -returning horses for
- -new horses for

14 days 30 days Don't share

- Feed or water buckets
- Grooming tools
- Manure forks
- Hay bags
- Tack

Before working with horses kept at home:

- -Wash your hands
- -Shower
- -Change clothes and footwear

Clean and disinfect stalls at the show facilities.

Limit exposure

-Avoid nose-to-nose contact between horses

-Limit the general public's contact with your horses
