Date: Saturday, December 6th, 2025

Time: 9:00 am - 11:00 am

This year Market Steer Registration forms will be ready for you at the weigh in on December 6th. If we miss a family blank forms will be available.

Each beef steer will be identified with an electronic RFID ear tag. Steers should not be born prior to January 1 of the previous fair year. Animals must be castrated prior to weighins. No horns will allowed at weigh-ins. Scurs are acceptable. Animals must be tagged by the official person who is tagging animals with the electronic RFID tag when it leaves the chute or it will not be considered registered for the 2026 Barron County Junior Livestock Market Animal project.

If your animal accidentally loses a tag at home, try to find the missing tag, and retain it in a zip lock bag and bring it to the fair.

Animals will be registered and weighed by the family.

Members are required to pay for the electronic tags their animals will be tagged with. Tag costs, are \$5.00 per tag (or per animal). (Example-if weighing in two animals, cost is \$10.00.) Please bring the exact amount as no change will be given back. Checks will be accepted and should be made payable to Barron County Junior Livestock Committee.

*Reminder, YQCA (**Youth Quality Care Assurance**) training is required and scheduled for Tuesday, March 3rd or Tuesday, March 24 @6:00 PM at the Barron High School Commons.

The Junior Livestock Kick-Off Meeting is also a required meeting and will be held on June 10th, 7:00 PM @ Rice Lake High School Auditorium.
