Bronco Bucks can be earned by members for attending and/or volunteering at the following Horse Project functions:

Sign advertisements:

- \$5 for the 1st 3 signs obtained
- \$10 for any sign after that
- \$25 for the top seller

Training Centers - \$10.00 Bronco Bucks will be earned for each training Center attended.

All Meetings - \$5.00 Bronco Bucks will be earned for each Monthly Educational meeting attended. If a meeting is held virtually, these count as well.

Scheduled approved horse shows: \$20/member/show

Fair - \$5.00 Bronco Bucks will be earned for each hour volunteered by a member or family member at the fair show.

Clean Up Night - \$5.00 Bronco Bucks will be earned for each hour volunteered to prepare the arena and stalls for the fair.

Misc. Horse Project sponsored hours - \$5.00 Bronco Bucks/hour will be earned for pre-approved Horse Project activities.

Totals will be added up at the end of the year and an auction will be held at the end of the year banquet.

Items will be purchased and/or donated throughout the year and displayed at the banquet.

Some auction items may include: Grooming kits, brushes, halters, lead ropes, leg wraps, tie downs, head stalls, blankets, shampoo, conditioner, saddle bags/covers, used show clothing, etc.
