

ARCHERY SAFETY RULES

- 1. Follow the instructions of the range commander.**
- 2. Always use proper safety equipment.**
- 3. Always use arrows of proper length.**
- 4. Always inspect your equipment before shooting.**
- 5. Wear snug fitting clothes, tie back long hair and Closed toed shoes**
- 6. Always aim and shoot only at a definite target.**
- 7. Always be sure the area around and behind your target is clear.**
- 8. POINT and DRAW your arrow only in the direction of the target.**
- 9. Never “DRYFIRE” your bow.**
- 10. Always walk, never run on the archery range.**
- 11. When done shooting, put down bows and stay off the line.**
- 12. Only shooters/certified leaders in front of blue/yellow line.**

13. Follow the commands:

SHOOTERS TO THE LINE

(2 whistle blasts)

bring bows and arrows to shooting line

IS THE FIRING LINE READY

The Line is Ready?

Ready on the right?

Ready on the left?

READY ON THE FIRING LINE?

NOCK AN ARROW AND

COMMENCE FIRING

(1 whistle blasts)

Begin shooting

Is Any More Time Needed?

CEASE FIRE or STOP - THE LINE IS CLOSED

(3 whistle blasts)

You may inspect your target and
retrieve your arrows.

CEASE FIRE

(4 or more whistle blasts)

stop what you are doing/stop shooting
