Market animal: official 840 tag number

Dairy: An official ear tag is a 9-digit alphanumeric tag like calfhood vac, for DHIA purposes or AI tech to ID heifers. If the registration number is used it must be accompanied with a copy of registration papers tying the animal to that number.

Sheep and Goats: Scrapes tag, 840 tag, or registration tattoo number, If registration tattoo is used it must be accompanied with a copy of the registration papers tying animal to that number.

Horse: must be accompanied with Health forms, Coggins test with a picture (may be a photograph added) to tie the two together.

Chickens/Poultry: band number
